Personal care items are required to be stored in dressing rooms, lockers or other areas designated for employee item storage. An exception to this is medicines, including refrigerated medicines.

Dry storage must meet NSF standards or equivalent and store food at least 6 inches off the floor. Any food displayed to the public must be packaged or have adequate sneeze protection.

According to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Life Safety Code, egress access corridors must be kept clear of obstructions at all times. This includes furniture, equipment, ...

OSHA requires that the garbage receptacles be easy to clean and large enough to prevent them from getting overly full. OSHA also forbids food storage in toilet areas or in areas with exposure to toxic ...

Alcoves in corridors can be used for storage as long as the stored items do not project into the corridor. Dead-end corridors may be used for storage or sitting areas as long as it occupies ...

Products must be stored on shelves or platforms 6 inches from the floor to ensure adequate cleaning of the storeroom floor. You don't want mop water contaminating your food.

SAFETY Hallway Storage and Emergency Egress General In order to ensure safe and efficient building evacuation and circulation, obstructions must be minimized and clearance must be maintained along ...

Food and Drinks must be stored in the break room area. Items such as flammable materials, illicit drugs, alcohol, firearms, inappropriate material etc., shall not be kept in the locker.
